Mobile phones

We understand that you may want your child to bring a mobile phone into school. If your child is going to bring their phone into school it either needs to be clearly labelled with their name or placed in a named bag - a freezer bag or similar - and handed into the office in the morning.

Beginning and end of day routines for Reception children.

Now that the children are really well settled, we are slightly altering our routines so the children have a calm beginning and end to the day.

- At the start of the day please wait outside the Reception garden in the main playground - a member of staff will open the gate at 8:45 and children may come straight into the classroom then. We would ask that children do not play in the garden before the start of school. A big thank you to all the parents who come in regularly in the morning to settle their child to an activity. This really sets the children up for the day.
- School officially starts at 8:55 and we will keep the door open until 9.00. If you arrive after 9.00, please take your child to the office. The office will inform the class teacher and a member of staff will come to collect the child from the office.
- The end of the day for the Reception class children is now in line with the rest of the school at 3:15 pm. Please wait in the main playground outside the Reception garden until a member of staff opens the gate.
